To: DSL Youth and Adult Referees:

Hope you've enjoyed the summer thus far. However, it's time to begin scheduling for fall season. Enclosed is your DSL referee availability form used to schedule DSL recreation games (including MSSA/HSSA for adults) throughout the fall.

This fall, **DSL will begin Saturday, August 23rd**, skips Labor Day weekend, and **end on October 25th**
MSSA (middle school) games will start September 3rd and HSSA, September 7th.

On the availability form, under "comments", you will find noted specific events taking place on those particular Saturdays or Sundays to assist you in marking your choices.

Please keep in mind the following:

- **MSSA players** – If we are not aware of your game schedule before we schedule referees, you may be scheduled for some Saturdays that may require you to be substituted.
- **Adults** – Be sure and check for conflicts with other schedules (including children) so that you can accurately indicate your availability.
- **Club players** – Check on tournaments in which you may be participating.
- **All** referees are expected to have a current concussion course certification, submitted, or previously submitted, an IRS W-9 form along with their Referee Availability form prior to refereeing.
- **Adult** referees must also be currently compliant with an approved background check.

Returning Referees: Please note that if your pre-printed form indicates in **red** that a requirement needs updated prior to refereeing, information will be included with this mailing to complete the requirement(s).
